Cal MediConnect is a new health care option that brings your health care and home services into one health plan.

You Have a Choice to Make About Your Care:

Select a Cal MediConnect Health Plan or a PACE plan*

OR

Keep your Medicare the same

OR

Do nothing

What You Need to Know in Los Angeles County



Why are these changes happening, and what does this mean to me?

Many Californians with both Medicare and Medi-Cal get their health care and home services from different providers who sometimes do not work together. This can cause confusion and frustration with getting the services and support you need.

Cal MediConnect brings your Medicare and Medi-Cal benefits into one health plan. The plan will also provide you with vision benefits and non-emergency medical transportation at no extra cost.
